The Early Childhood Educator Assistant (ECEA) Trainee will have excellent communication skills and demonstrates an energetic, nurturing and sensitive attitude that encourages healthy childhood development. You must be physically able to carry out child care functions (standing, bending, crouching and lifting up to 45 lbs.), maintain a positive attitude and uphold confidentiality within a busy team-based environment. As an ECEA Trainee you will perform a variety of activities (including but not limited to): assisting with classroom activities, supervising on field trips and playground time, providing support at meal and nap times and instilling healthy and independent practices with children.
